Although Cannabis is relatively safe, it is metabolized by many of the same enzymes that metabolize other drugs in our body. This competition for the metabolizing enzymes can affect the levels of other medications you might be taking. It is extremely important that you know if Cannabis will affect other medications you might be consuming. Go to the web site and click on the "Interaction Checker". Enter "Cannabis" or "Marijuana" in the interaction checker and then proceed to enter all other medications you are taking. If it shows a significant interaction, you should discuss this with your health care provider.

**Documentary on YouTube called "Weed" by Dr Sanja Gupta.** This is an excellent beginner guide into Medical Cannabis. Dr Gupta used to be opposed to Cannabis and even wrote a TIME magazine Op Ed against it. However, his investigation into the families dealing with unrelenting seizures, led him apologize and say he was wrong in opposing its use. He made at least 3 more documentaries in this series. Well worth watching.
